CATHOLIC UNDERGROUND INSPIRES!

About 350 stayed after the 6:00 p.m. Mass last Sunday to experience a moving and holy event. The Franciscan Friars brought their music and humble spirituality to St. Thomas Aquinas Parish for the attendees benefit.



We listened to words about how fortunate we Catholics are to have our Lord in the Eucharist, truly present among us any time we come to Mass or to the Adoration Chapel. How familiar He is to us, and how little many of us value His Real Presence.

A few inspiring words accompanied by holy music brought to light how blessed we are with such a caring, loving Savior in our midst. Alleluia!

STRENGTH FOR WHAT?

Today’s readings are powerful and give us insight into two great leaders of our early Church. In the second reading, we hear from Paul about how Christ stood by him during his trials because Paul kept his faith in Him. **The Lord “...gave me strength.”** Is what Paul wrote to Timothy to inspire him and his congregation to keep their faith.

But what did Paul mean by **keeping faith**? Our faith is not limited in tiny ways. It is grand in Christ’s design for us. **Our faith is one of discipleship**—as followers of Christ. And where does Christ take us? He takes us in His path, **a path of service to others** before Himself, **a conversion process** that never ends.

The U.S. Bishops describe this as *“Beginning in conversion, change of mind and heart, this commitment is expressed not in a single action, nor even in a number of actions over a period of time, but in an entire way of life.”*

Electronic Funds Transfer

We have successfully completed testing our Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) system for Sacrificial Giving donations. We now have just over one dozen parishioners who have their monthly or weekly donations deducted automatically from their savings or checking accounts.

For those of us who travel a lot on weekends, this is a great way to avoid missing a weekend! We still ask you to continue using your weekly envelopes when you come to Mass here (your option). This lets us know your attending Mass and gives you an opportunity to remember that you are a good steward. Beginning with the September envelope packet, we'll have a space to indicate you're using EFT and if you want to make any changes in your donations.

It's important to understand that our weekly donations should be a weekly decision. If we have a better week financially than usual, we should consider adding some to our weekly donation. Conversely, if we experience a long-term financial setback, we are always free to decrease our weekly donation.

Please call the parish office at 892-1511 or e-mail Stewardship@stanm.org if you need a form to begin automatic donations. You can still fulfill your stewardship responsibilities while making life just a little easier.

stewardship, the way of **giving back to God a portion** of what He gives us. Everything we have in the way of time, talent, and treasure comes from Him. Our faith teaches us this and our faith requires that we return a portion in His honor and glory.

It takes faith **to believe** this and **to do** this! Few of us seem to have sufficient faith, however. Few of us **donate to fund the Church** and even fewer give of our **time and talent in service for the Church**. We could do much more and meet far more needs if this were not true!

How strong is your faith in Christ? Do you openly accept the strength Christ offers when He calls you, **accept Him** enough to **believe in Him** and **to follow Him**? Our faith in Christ requires **action**. Lip service is not sufficient! ("Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, ¹⁰ but only the one who does the will of my Father in heaven.." Mt. 7:21)

Trust in Christ to give you the strength necessary to live your faith in Him. He will help you compete well. He will help you finish the race. **It is He** who will give you the strength you need to keep your faith. Step out of your comfort zone and pray about how you can serve Him more! **Get ready for 16 August!**

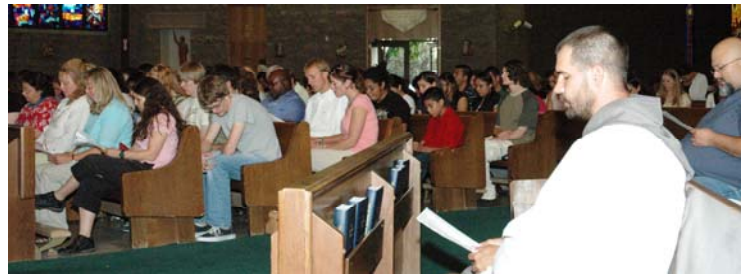
