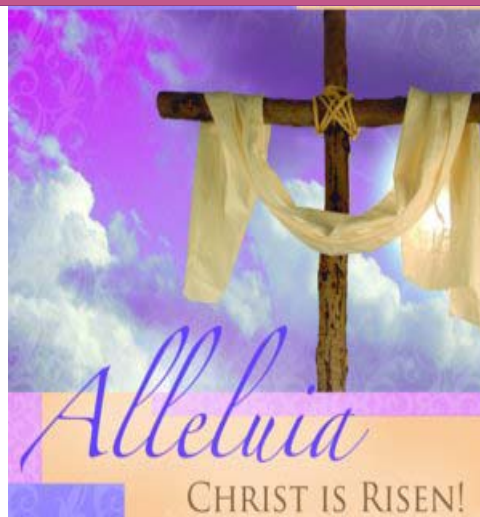

made it clear that the command to receive the Sacrament of Penance to obtain the promise of Mercy on Mercy Sunday need not be a confession on Mercy Sunday itself – our Lenten confession suffices, as long as we remain in the state of grace. There is no need for a special confession.

As promised, here is the prayer to use with the Easter Water to bless your home:

**Graciously hear us, Holy Lord,
Almighty Father and Eternal God,
that, even as You protected the homes of the Hebrew people leaving Egypt by means of the destroying angel; which homes were stained with the blood of a lamb (which prefigured our Pasch in which Christ was immolated); so may you in the same manner condescend to send your holy angel from heaven that he may guard, foster, protect, visit, and defend all the inhabitants of this dwelling. Through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen.**

(The house is then sprinkled with the blessed Easter water)

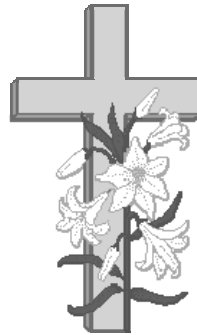

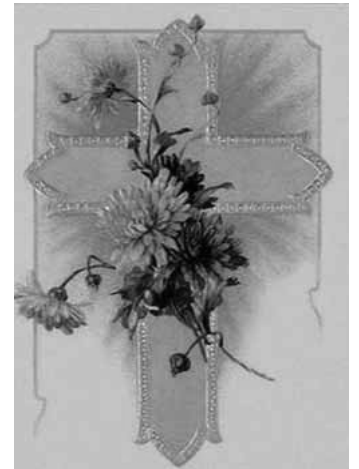
