the Feast of St. John Vianney –

**Monday, August 3, at 7:00 p.m.**

I would ask that now everyone plan on attending this event, joining in spirit with all the faithful of the Archdiocese in prayer for priests.

We will also have a solemn Mass on the Feast of St. John Vianney – **Tuesday, August 4, at 6:00 pm.**

There is a plenary indulgence attached to both of these events, under the usual conditions: confession, communion, and prayer for the Pope.

This Thursday is the feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel – a minor feast, but one very dear to the hearts of Catholics. It commemorates our Lady as the patroness of the Order of Mt. Carmel – the Carmelite friars and nuns throughout the world.

The symbol of this feast is the Scapular of our Lady of Mt. Carmel – often called the “Brown Scapular”. It is a “mini-habit” of the Carmelites, and is worn as a sign of devotion to our Lady. It symbolizes how as a mother cloths her children, so our Lady covers us with her powerful intercession. The Church permits it to be taught that those who die devoutly wearing the Scapular will enjoy our Lady’s special help in being released from purgatory.

In our Archdiocese we have our convent of Carmelite nuns. These wonderful women, who embrace one of the most strict and penitential rules of life, devote their entire life to prayer, especially for priests and the conversion of sinners. They support themselves by making the hosts that we use at Mass. How blessed we are that we have these women of prayer in our Archdiocese.

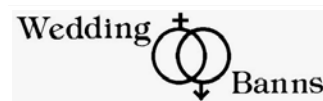
