This Monday I start teaching a new series on the History of the Catholic Church – a six week review of the glorious 2000 years of our history. Every Catholic should know the story of the Church – it is fascinating! Monday night, starting November 9th, 7 p.m., in D'Arco Hall.

All of November is a time of prayer for the faithful departed, and the remembrance of the Last Things.

God has given us so many helps to die a holy death, and to attain heaven. One of the most important are the Last Rites for the dying – Confession (with the Apostolic Blessing that carries with it a plenary indulgence), Anointing (if this has not been received already), Viaticum (Latin which means "the Food for the Journey" - the last Holy Communion) and the beautiful prayers for the dying.

We should take good care to receive the Last Rites in plenty of time, and let our loved ones know of our desire to receive them when we are in danger of death. It is the solemn duty of relatives to see that their loved ones receive the sacraments in due time, preferably when they are still conscience, and able to make their confession. It is a terrible mistake to wait until the person has died to call the priest. While we are happy to go bless the body and pray with the family, dead people cannot receive sacraments.

Our daily prayers should always include a petition that God will give of the grace of final perseverance and a holy death.

Next Sunday is our annual Stewardship Sunday, when we will review the principles of sacrificial giving, as we prepare to make our new financial commitment to the parish for the year 2010.

Congratulations to our varsity girls and boys teams who are the #1 ranked teams in the Albuquerque metro area. They beat out private and parochial schools in a series of races this fall to capture the title at the championship meet in October. Kudos also to the boys Junior Varsity team, which placed second.

The team credits coaches Frank and Bella Sanchez for leading them to victory. Mr. Sanchez ran high school track and held state records in sprinting.
