I will be gone this weekend and the next three days preaching a short parish mission at St. Anne's Parish in Tucumcari as that parish celebrates it's 100th anniversary.

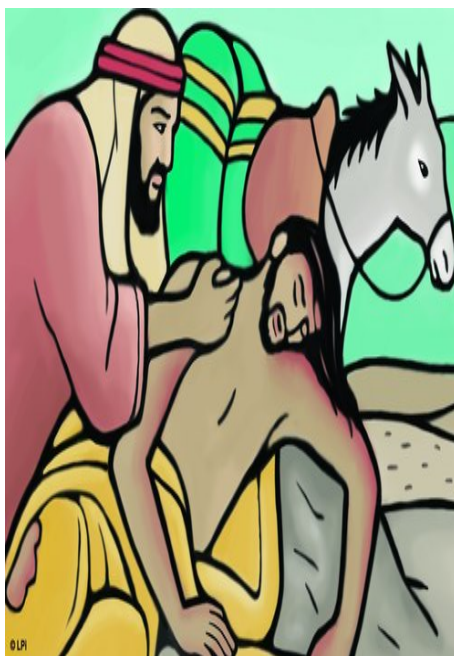

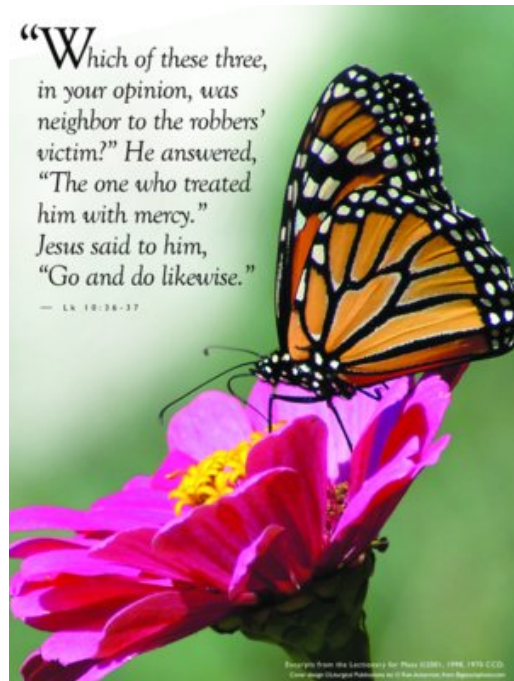

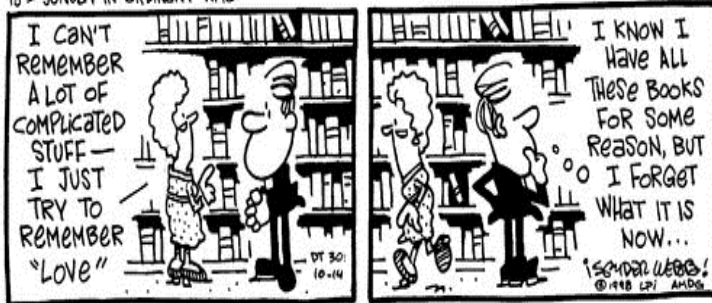
