Mr. Justin Bucalo, our great Youth Director of many years, has announced that he is leaving his position as of October 1 to become an officer in the United States Army. While we are very proud of his new calling, we are very sad to see him leave us, and the amazing work he has done building up youth ministry in our parish.

After an extensive search, we are happy to announce that Mr. John Hytown, of Phoenix, Az. John has been very involved in youth ministry in his own parish, and has recently graduated from Benedictine College with a double degree in Theology and Psychology. 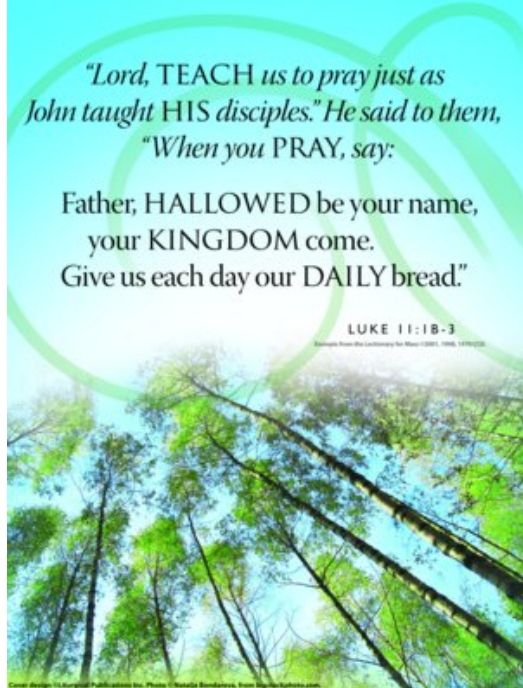

A bequest can be a specific dollar amount, a specific piece of property, a percentage of an estate, or all or part of the residue of an estate. You can also name St. Thomas Aquinas Parish as a contingent beneficiary in the event someone named in your will is no longer living. It is recommended that a lawyer help in drafting or amending a will.
